First Semester

PSYC 100 First Year Learning Experience.....	3 cr.
Composition (Based on Compass Score)	3 cr.
Math (Based on Compass Score)	4 cr.
CSCI 101 Introduction to Computer Application	3 cr.
Total Credits	12 cr.

Second Semester

Composition (Next course in sequence)	3 cr.
Math (Next course in sequence if applicable to degree).....	4 cr.
NAS 101 Lakota/Dakota Language, Speech, Science course or Introduction courses from major	9-12
Total Credits	12-17 cr.

A waiver of the required courses must be approved by the Vice President of Academics.

Second semester students should not be encouraged to take courses beyond the 13/14 credits unless they received a 2.00 or greater the first semester.
