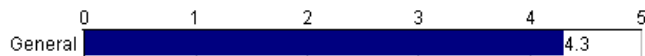

3	This specific outcome was revealed to me through my Composition II class, and my public speaking class. Because of these classes i have an articulate account on my experiences through oral and written communications.
4	This outcome was revealed to me at SBC through research papers, discussions (in class and online), reading and lectures. Learning how to do a research paper in English class helped me in other classes that required research papers.
5	This outcome was revealed to me during my first semester when I took the course created to help students become successful. I was taught time management skills and provided information and tools that guided me on the best ways to study and what was at my disposal to help me be a successful student/graduate of Sitting Bull College. Every teacher and advisor has had their own requirements for assignment completion which encouraged me to increase my vocabulary and improve my written communication skills. Any time I needed assistance all I had to do was ask which helped me meet a lot of new people, students and staff, who encouraged me to continue and also improved my oral communication skills.
6	The courses taken in getting my degree have honed my skills in writing and critical thinking.
7	The SBC faulty has provided me ways to help understand what I am reading about. And, numerous ways to break it down more in order for me to understand it more and retain more knowledge.
8	The English classes and the instructors were well taught. They were so much better than my experience in high school, I've learned a lot.
9	Speech and English Composition has helped me with my execution of thoughts from words to paper as well as my vocabulary.
10	Since i have been going to SBC I have enjoyed learning and coming to class each day. They have taught me how to use computers such as powerpoints, word excel and others. Also my critical thinking has been great as well I can solve problems on my own or ask my peers for help as well
11	Refreshing on the technical skills helped with writing papers for classes. The public speaking classes helped me to present projects I needed to do.

12	My LPN program requires critical thinking every day regarding patients and how I can solve problems on my own just listening and observing. Outside of school I can use those skills completing tasks and listening to the people around me rather than not paying attention
13	It was revealed to me in most of my classes but mainly roxy howes classes as I never really had to change the way I thought about things in a different way until I had her class and then I had to think differently and deeper to understand what was being taught. Changing the way I think and take things in has helped me through all my other classes. I will still continue to use it.
14	In many of my classes oral and written communication is demonstrated by not only the instructors, but also the students. Students are encouraged by instructors to speak in class, express opinions and give feedback. Knowing that I was going to have to speak in classes like Interviewing, Speech, and Management in Human Services, I was able to build some confidence and express myself in a different way than I was used to.
15	I would say my Composition and Environmental Statistics classes were the leading places with which I came to understand technical and critical thinking skills. Both taught me to question sources of information, study and understand it, and report it in my own way with as little bias as possible.
16	I was always nervous and scared to talk in front of a classroom full of people. Until I had the speech course which taught me a lot. I am less nervous and not scared to talk in front of a classroom full of people. It's a learning experience and the more you do it the better you become. 8	Living in the dorm's with younger students I have learned to listen. I have become accustomed to younger students looking to me for advice.
9	Just being in the environment of sbc where everyone is so positive and helpful it makes a person want to be the same way and have a positive attitude towards everything
10	In my environmental science courses it was required to take Environmental Sampling. I was very curious to see what this course will be like. I learned a lot in this course, each student had to lead the group on a particular topic. I was very nervous when it was my turn to lead the class to what we would be sampling and surprisingly it was fairly easily. I had no fear in leading the class and telling them what to do and how to do it.
11	In every class, I was provided a syllabus that reviewed the expectations for that class. The instructors reviewed those expectations and answered any questions I had. Before attending SBC I had issues with attendance while employed, but I learned how to be responsible, dependable, respectful and how to hold myself accountable to turn in assignments as expected and on time. 2	Through my internship i was able to get the feel of a nice working environment and that will in turn help me during and after college

3	Through my business administration classes I was taught how to function independently and cooperatively within many different diverse environments. In most business classes we focus on the best, most efficient way to work.
4	Through direct and indirect instruction every classes I have taken has developed my work ethic and ability to function independently and cooperatively in the classroom environment.
5	This outcome was revealed to me at SBC through other students, faculty and instructors demonstrating these skills and encouraging me to do the same. This outcome helped me do my assignments and work with other students.
6	The environmental science internship taught me to work with others and to be independent.
7	Perhaps it was my Public Speaking class that taught me this lesson the hardest. I admit that group work has never been my favorite but sometimes it's required to get things done in a timely manner. However, in the case of that class we had issue with half of our four-person group either ignoring the work or just not showing up. 4	This past summer I took Lakota language and spent my summer with people from all over the world.
5	This outcome was revealed to me at SBC through the Native American courses I took, through the displayed artwork and through events. This outcome made me feel proud to be a student at SBC and a Native American.
6	The classes taught for this were so interesting, I wish I can go back and continue learning about our ways but its not my type of studying. I loved it but I love what I am majoring in right now. I love that the college has so much to do with our language and ways. Its nice to see the instructors trying to learn and interacting with the language everyday.
7	Taking a language class and being involved with culture club. I love the language class and it taught me how to speak some Lakota and now I would like to learn more for my son who is in the immersion nest as well as having my internship in the nest
8	Sitting Bull College does an excellent job in giving students the opportunity to learn and appreciate Native American cultures through the instructors who teach this subject. The amount of knowledge those instructors have is extraordinary. I took a Native American Tribal Government class last semester and it really made me appreciate where I come from so much because of the historic oppression Native Americans have endured.
9	Since attending sittingbull college I have had the chance to learn more about my culture. I believe this is the most rewarding thing of sittingbull, is I always feel as if I learning not only about things related to my career but also I have a chance to learn the culture ways that was never taught to so many growing up. I see sittingbull college as on of the biggest assets not only to the standing rock reservation but to all Sioux people. my child is also in the nest and I love it, I love everything the college offers. coming here has been life changing for me thank you for all that was given to me
10	SBC is located on the Standing Rock Reservation. I am from across the country with no ties to the culture or community. That said, I have come to appreciate the Native American culture and how important it can be to the community. There are of course a number of people who carry a Native American title and only refer to it when it comes time to apply for scholarships or benefits then ignore it afterwards, but that is to be expected in any culture. It's the people who take it far more seriously than that, those who wish to live their life around the adapted culture of those who came before them that I respect. While I may not share their culture, I have certainly come to respect it.
11	In my sampling class we went to Sitting Bull Camp, and Michael Moore told us the history that had happened at the location we were at. It made me understand my culture in a different perspective.
12	Im glad SBC has a handle on the appreciation of our culture, my first semester i took a lakota class and i learned alot about the culture and the language and it inspired me to want to learn more.
13	I was not raised around the Dakotas so I never knew a whole lot about my own culture. I have learned so much, but am excited to learn more. I feel like there was a big part of myself that was missing and I am slowly filling in the void as I learn about my Lakota culture on a daily basis.
14	I was already proud and appreciative to be lakhota'. But, sitting bull College has helped me in the history portion of the culture
15	I have learned a lot from taking the Native American classes here. I've learned basic language to learning more about where we came from and how we evolved and came to be.
16	I have gained a lot of appreciation for Native American culture and have learned a lot through my time at SBC.

17	I have a good understanding and appreciation for Native American cultures because I took a class on the language. It will help me achieve my educational goals because I know a lot about the Native American culture and language. If I were to work on the reservation, I would know what to do, what not to do, and hopefully speak the language well enough to gain trust in some of my clients.
18	I grew up on the reservation half my life and have take a few classes on Native American history and Language. it will always play an important role in my life and culture. We are not only representing the school but our tribe as a whole as well. Its important to always have pride in our culture and respect.
19	I already had an understanding of Native American Cultures taking courses here at SBC it has me obtain more knowledge.
20	Even though I understand this is a tribal school, I believe it should be up to the students if they want to engage in native American culture or language. I really don't think its fair that language and taking a native class is required if a student is not interested in that field or learning about it.
